Student success is measured below in a variety of ways to address equity, diversity and inclusion. My students come from across two campuses, and a diverse range of socio-economic and cultural backgrounds, some may struggle with securing funds for festival applications or exhibition fees. Competitive scholarships, job placement and corporate careers are occasionally more aligned with those students goals, but still speaks to the success of students creative practice and study in the DMD program.
